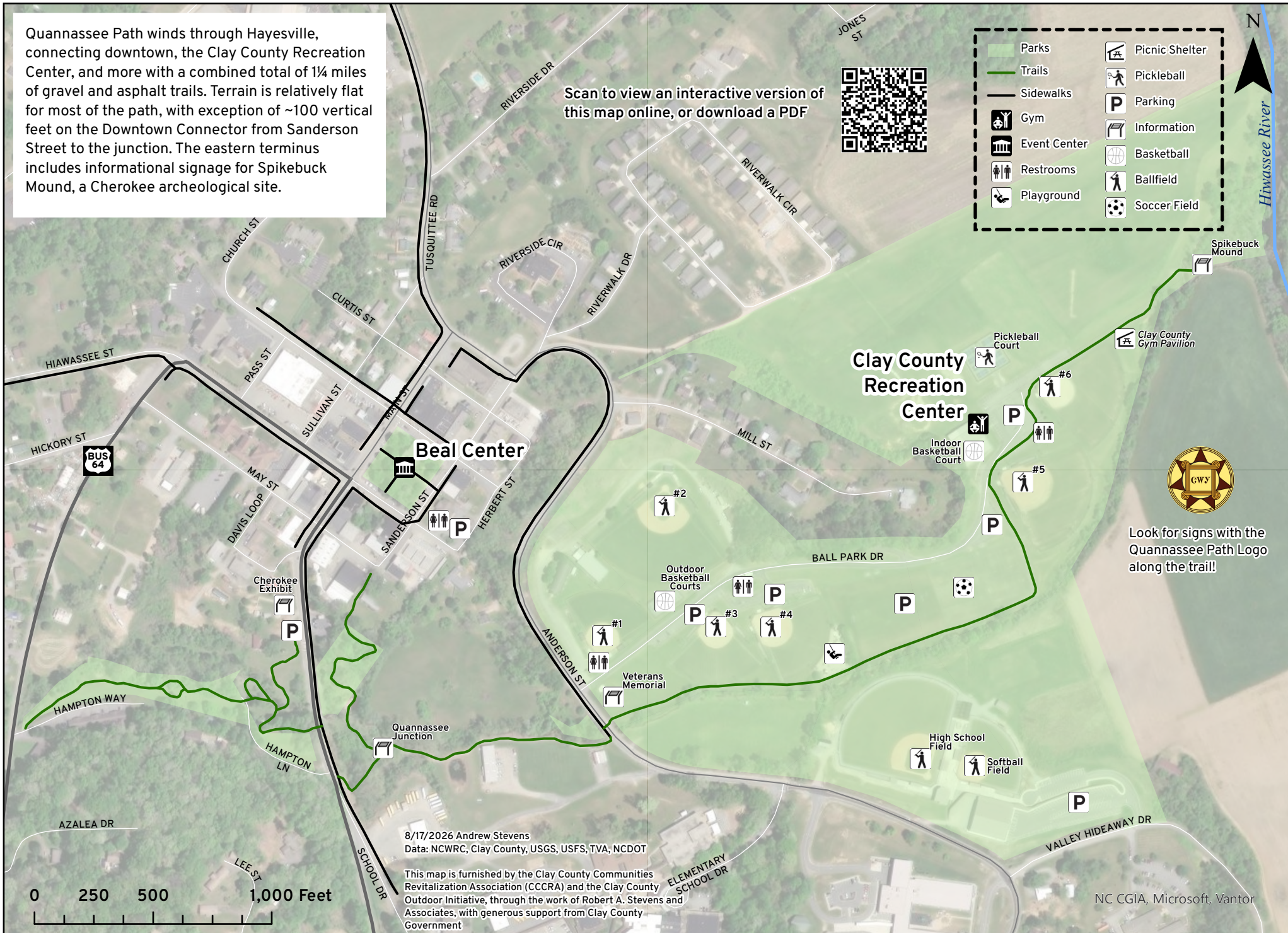


Hayesville, North Carolina Parks, Trails, and Recreation

Quannassee Path winds through Hayesville, connecting downtown, the Clay County Recreation Center, and more with a combined total of 1¼ miles of gravel and asphalt trails. Terrain is relatively flat for most of the path, with exception of ~100 vertical feet on the Downtown Connector from Sanderson Street to the junction. The eastern terminus includes informational signage for Spikebuck Mound, a Cherokee archeological site.
