

Historic Hayesville Inc. will provide transportation on Red Ryder from downtown parking areas to events on the square beginning Saturday, May 14 during the annual Mayor's Yard Sale with bargains galore. Gardens & Grub is a new event sponsored by Master Gardeners featuring vendors with items for home or garden and will be inside the Historic Clay County Courthouse/Beal Center grounds on the same day. Coffee and breakfast items will be available from HHI from 8-11 a.m. followed by food with Master Gardeners until 4 p.m. The 8th annual Steins & Wine Around the Square returns on Saturday, May 21 from 4 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. with at least 10 brewery and wine vendors. New breweries will be available and area favorites will return with beer, wine, mead and non-alcohol drinks to enjoy with food or snacks. Tickets are available at the HHI Centennial Exhibit on Sanderson Street next to Hayesville Post Office or Tiger's Store on Herbert Street.

Clay County Communities Revitalization Association will kick off the summer concert series at 7 p.m. on Friday, May 27 with local favorite Wyatt Espalin & Friends. Red Ryder will begin picking up attendees from downtown event parking areas at 6 p.m. with drop off at entries to the Historic Clay County Courthouse/Beal Center grounds and return to parking from the same areas.

HHI volunteer drivers will also deliver patrons to downtown restaurants during times of events if needed. Drivers can deliver attendees to and from parking areas but cannot travel outside downtown so everyone should have a safe ride home after any of the events.
